Chanson Père & Fils is one of the oldest of Beaune's great négociant houses, having been founded in 1750 and in 1999 the company was sold to Bollinger of the champagne fame. **Domaine Chanson**, provides about a quarter of the company's production which extends to Chablis, the Mâconnais and the Beaujolais. Its own vineyards are entirely in the Côte de Beaune.

Bodegas Aragonesas is situated in the Campo de Borja region just to the South of Rioja and Navarra and sources only the best fruit from local cooperatives after which they give it all the love and attention, using innovative processes to produce some extraordinary wines.
